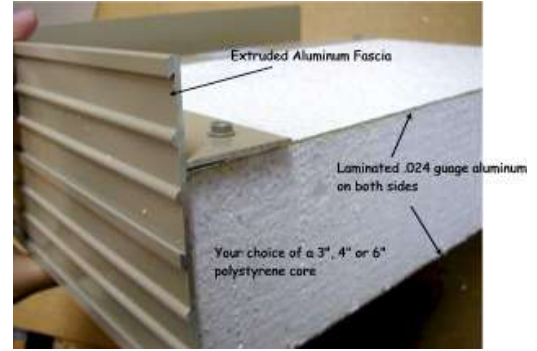

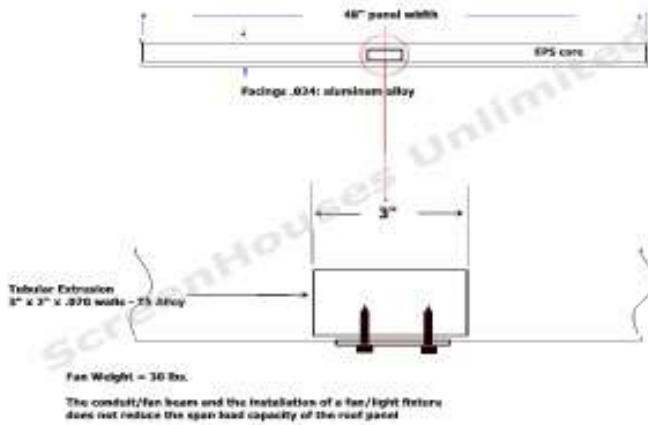

- Each roof panel is made up of a polystyrene core with an .024 gauge laminated aluminum on both sides.
- Optional fan beam panel designed to hold your ceiling fan!
- Downspouts are NOT included with the unit and are easily purchased locally.
- The front fascia gutter contains a full rain gutter system including scuppers to direct the water run off away from your unit (downspouts purchased locally)
- This is a very high quality, long lasting patio cover that is easily assembled within one to two days depending on the size you are building.

This above is a cutaway of the roof section. It is available in 3", 4" & 6" thicknesses all with the specially formulated polystyrene core with an .024 laminated aluminum skin on both sides. Shown here with the extruded aluminum fascia screwed into place.



**Option:** fan beam panel - a roof panel designed to hold the weight of a ceiling mounted fan! See diagram to the left... In all patio cover assemblies, the size of beam, beam placement, number of posts and distance between posts are all dependant on your local load rating requirements... Call us for a quotation on any size insulated patio cover.

Each of the FULL PATIO COVER units below come with: 4" thick roof panels, (5) panels each at 4' wide, (1) x 20' long 3"x3" x .125" extruded aluminum beam, rear extruded and thermally broken header, side extruded fascia, front extruded gutter, (4) x 8' tall 3"x3" x .125" square extruded aluminum posts with top & bottom brackets, 5" lags for panel to beam connection, sealant, tar tape, drain scuppers, all necessary hardware and touch up paint.

## Features:

Insulated Patio Cover Systems come with... Instructions, all panels, beam, rear extruded and thermally broken C channel, side extruded fascia, front extruded gutter, screws & hardware, lags for panel to beam connection, posts, sealant, drain scuppers, touch up paint, tar tape, and top post brackets and hardware. Hardware to mount the back-wall 'C' channel to be purchased locally.

## How To Get A Quotation...

We will gladly supply a quotation under the following guidelines...

Our pre-engineered kits are put together to conform to 2011 International Building Code standards. We will not help our customers take short cuts. For your safety and insurance purposes we will need the following information before considering your request for quotation...



You will need to obtain, from your local building department, a "pounds per square foot" load requirement as well as a "miles per hour" wind load requirement. We use these numbers to determine which thickness of panel you need (we have 3), whether you need a beam, and if you do, what size (we have 7 different sizes!), where the beam should go (for safety), how many posts are necessary and the spacing between posts!

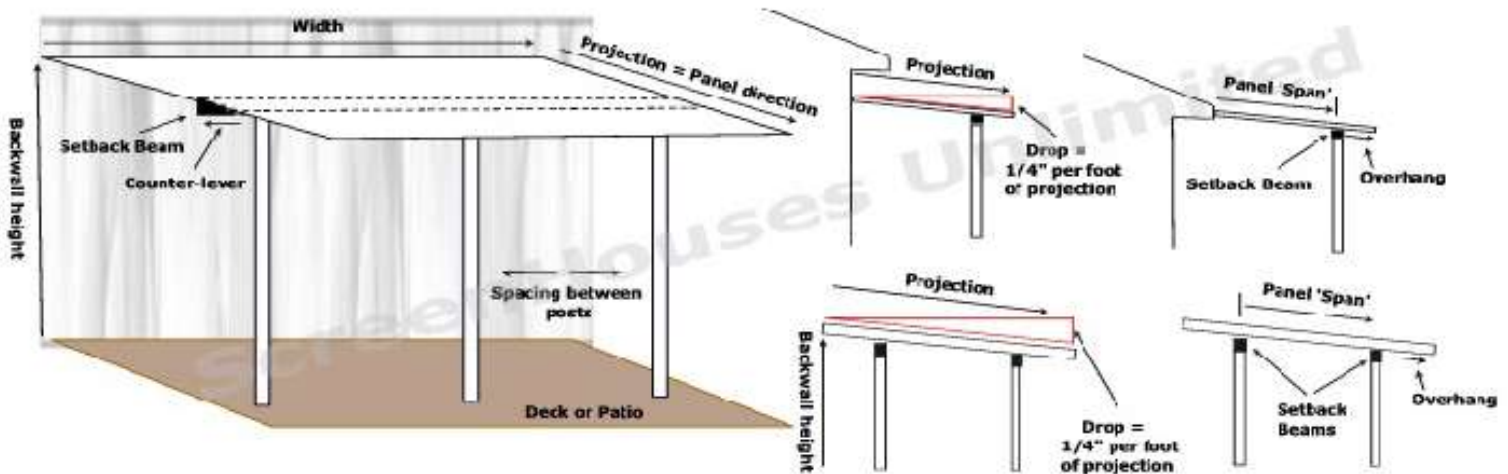
\*\*As you can see, load requirements are VERY important for both safety and so that you are not paying for more than you need!

## Measuring (see diagram above for terminology)

We will need a back wall height measurement - either how high on your house wall will you be attaching your patio cover or the ground to eave measurement if attaching to the front fascia board

We will need your desired projection and width. If you are covering the entire deck, we suggest a 1' overhang on both sides and the front. We will need to know if you are attaching the unit to an existing deck or patio surface OR are you cementing the posts into the ground. We will need to know if you have a chimney work-around with all the measurements. Extra inside and outside corners will be provided.
